Building Better Opportunities

The Building Better Opportunities programme, which is funded by the Big Lottery Fund and European Social Fund, aims to help those who experience multiple barriers to work, in finding a job or in being better placed to look for work.

South Staffordshire Work Clubs provide job search skills, assistance with job applications, interview skills, careers advice, benefits advice, ICT Training, numeracy and literacy skills, financial and budgeting advice, personal skills development, team building and work experience placements with local businesses.

The Key areas of support will be;

- Work skills - gaining of key skills e.g. team working, problem solving, numeracy, IT and communication skills.**
- Attitudinal skills - increased levels of motivation, confidence, feelings of responsibility, levels of self-esteem and higher personal and career aspirations.**
- Personal skills - improved timekeeping, personal hygiene, greater levels of self-awareness, better health and fitness, greater levels of concentration and engagement.**
- Practical skills - ability to complete forms, ability to write a CV, improved ability to manage money and improved awareness of rights and responsibilities.**
